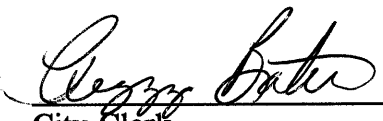

A resolution was presented notifying the Department of Environmental Management that the city had reviewed the Municipal Water Pollution Prevention Annual Report for the Pelham Waste Water Treatment Plant and set forth actions to maintain effluent requirements contained in the NPDES Permit, and to prevent the bypass and overflow of raw sewage within the collection system or at the treatment plant. Ken Maynard moved to approve the resolution as presented. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved.

A resolution was presented advancing \$250 to Karen Bragan for expenses while attending Municipal Court School in Tuscaloosa, AL., March 1-3, 1995. Karyl Rice moved to approve the resolution as presented. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and all approved.

Ordinance No. 110-83d amending fines was introduced. Ken Maynard moved to suspend the rules for immediate consideration. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and a roll call vote was taken with all members of the council present answering yea to suspend the rules. Thereupon, Willard Payne moved to approve Ordinance No. 110-83d as presented. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and all approved.
