Willard Payne moved to approve the February 20, 1995 minutes as presented. Ken Maynard seconded the motion and all approved.

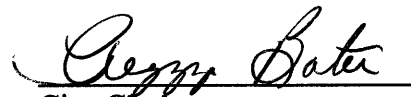
There was no old business to come before the council.
