

The Pelham City Council convened at 7:00 p.m., June 5, 1995. Mayor Hayes called the meeting to order. Ken Maynard lead the invocation.

Mayor Hayes asked that the record show all members of the council present except Jim Phillips.

Connie LaBue moved to approve the May 15, 1995 minutes as written. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved.

There was no old business to come before the council.

During new business Charlotte Lusco, Principal at Riverchase Middle School, presented Mayor Hayes and each council member with a cup and the city with a proclamation of appreciation for contributions.

A resolution was presented approving 6 street lights in Emerald Lake Subdivision, 4 street lights in Hampton Estates, 6 street lights in High Hampton Subdivision and one street light at 3371 N. Wildewood Drive. Willard Payne moved to approve the resolution. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

Karyl Rice announced two public hearings to be held June 19, 1995, at 7:00 p.m.

The first hearing will be to consider rezoning property owned by Joseph R. Allen from R-2 Multiple Dwelling District to B-4 General Business District. The property is located on Clark Drive.

The second hearing will be to consider rezoning property owned by Steve Mobley from A-1 Agricultural to Special District. The property adjoins Heather Ridge subdivision.

Ken Maynard moved to change the July 3 council meeting to July 10. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

With no other business before the council, Willard Payne moved to adjourn. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and all approved.
