

The Pelham City Council met July 10, 1995, at 7:00 p.m. Mayor Hayes called the meeting to order, and Ken Maynard led the invocation. Mayor Hayes asked that the record show all members of the Council present.

There was no old business to come before the Council.

During new business a Traffic Control Signal Agreement with the Alabama Department of Transportation for signalization at US 31 and Chandalar Drive was presented. Willard Payne moved to approve the agreement. Ken Maynard seconded the motion and all approved.

Ordinance No. 269, annexing Randall Goggins Property on Highway 11 was presented. Jim Phillips moved to suspend the rules for immediate consideration. Karyl Rice seconded the motion, and a roll call vote was taken with all members of the council agreeing to suspend the rules. Thereupon Jim Phillips moved to approve Ordinance No. 269 as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

Ordinance No. 270, establishing standards to eliminate and reduce excessive community sounds or other noises was presented. Jim Phillips moved to suspend the rules for immediate consideration, and Connie LaBue seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken with all members of the Council agreeing to suspend the rules. Thereupon Jim Phillips moved to approve Ordinance No. 270 as presented. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved.

Ordinance No. 271, annexing Archie Phillips property adjoining Weatherly was presented. Karyl Rice moved to suspend the rules for immediate consideration. Willard Payne seconded the motion, and a roll call vote was taken with all members agreeing to suspend the rules. Thereupon Karyl Rice moved to approve Ordinance No. 271 as presented. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and all approved.

A resolution approving the Partnership Interest Acquisition and the ownership by Marcus and its affiliates of all the partnership interests of the Franchisee was introduced. Ken Maynard moved to approve the resolution as presented. Jim Phillips seconded the motion and all approved.

A resolution authorizing Mayor Hayes to enter into an agreement with the State of Alabama Department of Transportation and the City of Hoover for improvements to the traffic signal installation at the intersection of Alabama Highway 251 and Old Montgomery Highway was introduced. Ken Maynard moved to approve the resolution as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

A request for additional street lights in the Stratford subdivision was presented. This was referred to Paul Yeager for a report at the July 17 meeting.

Jim New with Belle Vista homeowners showed a video of flooding in their mobile home park. It was suggested that the homeowners get an attorney and contact the property owner.

With no other business before the Council, Ken Maynard moved to adjourn. Jim Phillips seconded the motion and all approved.
