

The Pelham City Council convened at 7:00 p.m., September 11, 1995. Mayor Hayes called the meeting to order, and Ken Maynard led the invocation.

During old business the council considered placing a street light on Kristen Drive. Mayor Hayes stated that Paul Yeager recommended that a light be placed near 2315 Kristen Drive due to the terrain and lack of light. Karyl Rice moved to approve the light as recommended. Ken Maynard seconded the motion and all approved.

During new business, a resolution concerning Alabama Department of Transportation Project No. STPBH-7112 (1) widening CR-17 from U.S. 31 to I-65 was presented. Ken Maynard moved to approve the resolution as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

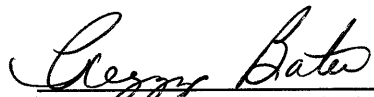
An application for retail table wine and retail beer (on and off premise) for Pateras' Pizza and Subs (formerly Mata's Pizza) was presented. Willard Payne moved to approve the application as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

Ordinance No. 273, an ordinance to require and regulate minimum lighting requirements at certain businesses providing entertainment to the general public was introduced and will be voted on at the 9/18/95 council meeting.

Ordinance No. 275, a franchise agreement with Shelby Cable was introduced. Ken Maynard moved to suspend the rules for immediate consideration. Willard Payne seconded the motion and a roll call vote was taken with the following results: Mayor Hayes - yes, Ken Maynard - yes, Karyl Rice - yes and Willard Payne - yes. Thereupon Willard Payne moved to approve the agreement as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

Mayor Hayes presented the City Budget for the 1995/96 fiscal year. Ken Maynard moved to approve the budget as presented. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved.
