Mayor Hayes asked that the record show all members of the council present except Jim Phillips.

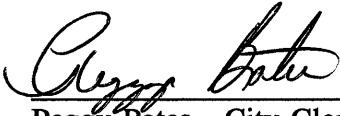
Karyl Rice moved to approve the September 11, 1995, minutes as presented. Ken Maynard seconded the motion and all approved.
