

The Pelham City Council convened at 7:00 p.m., February 5, 1996. Mayor Hayes called the meeting to order and Ken Maynard led the invocation.

Mayor Hayes asked that the record show all members of the Council present except Connie LaBue.

Ken Maynard moved to approve the January 15, 1996 minutes as presented. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved.

During old business Mayor Hayes announced that Robert Fortenberry's request for rezoning had been withdrawn. Karyl Rice moved to table Thurman Wilson's request for rezoning until March 4, 1996. Jim Phillips seconded the motion and all approved.

During new business, a resolution was presented removing two street lights at the intersection of Highway 31 and Chandalar Drive. Ken Maynard moved to approve the resolution as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

A resolution authorizing the City to participate in Team Alabama for the 1996 Olympics was presented. Jim Phillips moved to approve an expenditure of \$15,000 to the Alabama Sports Foundation for participation in Team Alabama. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved.

Ordinance No. 280 establishing buffer and landscaping regulations was presented. Jim Phillips moved to suspend the rules for immediate consideration. Ken Maynard seconded the motion and a roll call vote was taken with all members of the Council answering yes to suspend the rules. Thereupon, Jim Phillips moved to approve Ordinance No. 280 as written. Ken Maynard seconded the motion and all approved.

An application for retail beer on and off premises for Golden Rule BBQ was presented. Jim Phillips moved to approve as presented. Willard Payne seconded the motion and it passed with a vote of four to one.

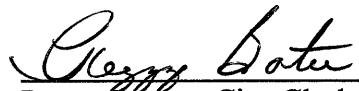
