

The Pelham City Council convened at 7:00 p.m., March 4, 1996. Mayor Hayes called the meeting to order.

Ken Maynard led the invocation.

Mayor Hayes asked that the record show all members of the Council present except Jim Phillips.

During old business, a resolution authorizing street lights in Weatherly was presented. Karyl Rice moved to approve the resolution. Ken Maynard seconded the motion and all approved.

A public hearing was held to consider changing the zoning of property located at 2124 Old Montgomery Highway from B-2 General Business to O-I Office and Institutional, Ordinance No. 135-66. Mr. Thurman Wilson was the applicant. No one spoke in opposition or in favor of the rezoning. Karyl Rice stated that the Planning Commission voted unanimously to recommend rezoning to the City Council. Karyl Rice moved to approve Ordinance 135-66 as presented. Ken Maynard seconded the motion and all approved.

A public hearing was held to consider amending the Zoning Ordinance, changing the fee for rezoning from \$250 to \$300. Karyl Rice stated that the Planning Commission recommended unanimously to approve the change. Karyl Rice moved to approve Ordinance No. 135-67 as presented. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved.

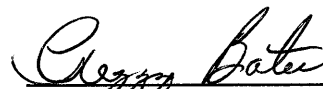
During new business Ordinance No. 281 rescinding Ordinance No. 280 was presented. Karyl Rice moved to suspend the rules for immediate consideration. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and a roll call vote was taken with all members present agreeing to suspend the rules. Thereupon, Ken Maynard moved to approve Ordinance No. 281 as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

A resolution appointing Joel Price, Jim Courtney and Diane Lucas to the Board of Adjustments for a three year term was introduced. Connie LaBue moved to approve the resolution as presented. Ken Maynard seconded the motion and all approved.

A resolution approving an agreement between Oak Mountain Amphitheater and the City of Pelham and authorizing the Mayor to enter into said agreement was presented. Willard Payne moved to approve the resolution as presented. Ken Maynard seconded the motion and all approved.

Mayor Hayes recognized Jon Golden from Alabama Power.

With no other business before the council, Ken Maynard moved to adjourn. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and all approved.
