

The Pelham City Council convened at 7:00 p.m., Monday, April 1, 1996. Mayor Hayes called the meeting to order and Ken Maynard led the invocation. Mayor Hayes asked that the record show all members of the council present except Connie LaBue.

Ken Maynard moved to approve the March 18, 1996 meeting. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved.

Mayor Hayes assured the residents that the developer, Steve Mobley, was very good to work with and that the city would pursue an alternative if possible.
