

The Pelham City Council convened at 7:00 p.m., Monday, May 6, 1996. Mayor Hayes called the meeting to order, and Ken Maynard led the invocation.

Mayor Hayes asked that the record show all members of the council present except Jim Phillips.

Ken Maynard moved to approve the April 15, 1996, minutes as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

During old business, a public hearing was held to consider Ordinance No. 135-70 amending the zoning district boundaries of the city changing the present zoning of A-1 Agricultural to B-2 General Business on property located at 155 Winslett Road. The applicant was Howard Winslett. Karyl Rice stated that the Planning Commission voted unanimously to recommend rezoning to the city council. Connie LaBue moved to approve the ordinance as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

Paul Yeager reported that no additional stop signs were needed in Royal Oaks. Mayor Hayes asked the Police Department to add patrols to enforce the speed limit in the subdivision.

During new business, Mayor Hayes read a proclamation recognizing the week of May 6-11 as Municipal Clerk's Week.

Mayor Hayes announced that the next city council meeting would be May 13 due to the Alabama League of Municipalities meeting during May.

With no other business before the council, Willard Payne moved to adjourn. Ken Maynard seconded the motion and all approved.
