Ken Maynard moved to approve the May 6, 1996 minutes as presented. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved.

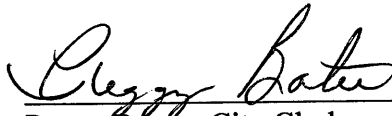
There was no old business to come before the council.
