Mayor Hayes asked that the record show all members of the council present except Connie LaBue.

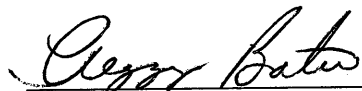
Ken Maynard moved to approve the June 17, 1996 minutes as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.
