

The Pelham City Council convened at 7:00 p.m., Monday, August 5, 1996. Mayor Hayes called the meeting to order and Ken Maynard led the invocation.

Mayor Hayes asked that the record show all members of the council present.

Ken Maynard moved to approve the July 15, 1996, minutes as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

There was no old business to come before the council.

During new business, a resolution requesting street light changes at Pelham High School was presented. Willard Payne moved to approve the resolution as written. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and all approved.

A resolution appointing Peggy Bates to the Planning Commission to fill the unexpired term of Mike Morgan was presented. Ken Maynard moved to approve the resolution. Jim Phillips seconded the motion and all approved. Her term will expire in September 2000.

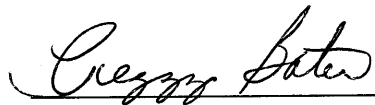
A request from the developer of Cambrian Ridge to amend the set back lines on this special district from 20 feet to a minimum of 15 feet was considered. Jim Phillips moved to approve the request. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

Mayor Hayes presented the resolution declaring the city council members and mayor duly elected to office. A presentation of certificates of election followed.

Karyl Rice announced a public hearing to be held August 19, 1996, at 7:00 p.m. at Pelham City Hall to consider Ordinance No. 135-71 an amendment to the zone district boundaries of the City of Pelham changing the present zoning of A-1 Agricultural to Special District on property located on the corner of Highway 261 and Aaron Road. The applicant is Mildred Terry.

Mayor Hayes recognized a scout member, James Darden, from Troop 254 working on his communication badge.

With no other business before the council, Willard Payne moved to adjourn. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.
