

The Pelham City Council convened at 7:00 p.m. Monday, September 16, 1996. Mayor Hayes called the meeting to order and Willard Payne led the invocation. Mayor Hayes asked that the record show all members of the council present.

Ken Maynard moved to approve the September 9, 1996 minutes as presented. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved.

During old business Jim Phillips moved to approve a street light on Keystone Court, Pole #S606. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and all approved.

During new business, a resolution advancing the following cash to employees was presented - \$125 to Captain E. A. Thomas while attending Alabama Polygraph Association Seminar October 10-24 in Huntsville, AL; \$250 to Investigator P. T. Pritchard for expenses while attending a training session for the Alabama Narcotics Officers Association October 16-18 in Gulf Shores, Alabama; \$250 to Donna Treslar for expenses while attending City Clerk School October 9-11 in Tuscaloosa, Alabama.

Ordinance No. 270-1 amending the noise ordinance was presented. Jim Phillips moved to suspend the rules for immediate consideration. Ordinance No. 182-3 amending the Park & Recreation Ordinance adding a section for tennis lessons was presented. Willard Payne moved to suspend the rules for immediate consideration. Connie LaBue seconded the motion and a roll call vote was taken with the following results: Bobby Hayes, yes; Willard Payne, yes; Connie LaBue, yes; Ken Maynard, yes; Karyl Rice, yes and Jim Phillips yes. Thereupon, Willard Payne moved to approve the ordinance as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

An application for retail beer transfer of license for Valleydale Texaco Food Mart was presented. Jim Phillips moved to approve the application as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and it passed with a five to one vote.

Mayor Hayes read a proclamation designating September 27, 1996, Share Life Day in the City of Pelham.
