A resolution was presented appointing Brad Bishop, Municipal Judge. Ken Maynard moved to approve the resolution as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

A resolution was presented appointing Charlie D. Waldrep, Prosecuting Attorney. Willard Payne moved to approve the resolution as presented. Jim Phillips seconded the motion and all approved.

A resolution was presented appointing Mayor Hayes, Superintendent of the Water Board. Jim Phillips moved to approve the resolution as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

Mayor Hayes announced the need to elect a Mayor Pro Tem. Jim Phillips nominated Willard Payne. Ken Maynard seconded the motion and all approved.

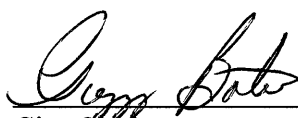

- 3) Ordinance No. 135-75 changing the zoning from R-1 Residential to Special District on property located on King Valley Road East and King Valley Drive West. Applicant - James L. King.
- 4) Ordinance No. 135-76 changing the zoning from R-1 Residential to B-1 Business District on property located on Highway 261. Applicant - Donnie Tucker.
- 5) Ordinance No. 135-77 changing the zoning from B-2 Business District to O & I Office and Institutional on property located in Chandalar, west of Highway 31. Applicant - Donnie Tucker.
