

The Pelham City Council convened at 7:00 p.m., Monday, November 4, 1996. Mayor Pro Tem, Willard Payne, called the meeting to order.

Karyl Rice led the invocation and Mr. Payne asked that the record show all members of the council present except Mayor Hayes and Mike Dickens.

Ordinance No. 289, regarding gasoline and gasoline products was read, and an announcement was made that it would be voted on at the November 18 meeting.

Ordinance No. 290 annexing Oak Mountain Church of God was presented. Jim Phillips moved to suspend the rules for immediate consideration. Ken Maynard seconded the motion, and a roll call vote was taken with all members present voting yes to suspend the rules. Jim Phillips moved to approve Ordinance No. 290 as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

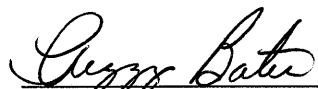

Ken Maynard moved to approve the resolution as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

Karyl Rice announced a public hearing to be held November 18, 1996, at 7:00 p.m. to consider Ordinance No. 135-72 amending zoning on a piece of property located on Morgan Park Road from R-3 to M-1. The applicant was Ben Chenault.

With no other business before the council, Karyl Rice moved to adjourn. Jim Phillips seconded the motion and all approved.
