

The Pelham City Council convened at 7:00 p.m., May 12, 1997. Mayor Hayes called the meeting to order and Willard Payne led the invocation.

2) To consider changing the zoning from B-2 General Business District to B-4 General Business District on property located at the Intersection of U. S. Highway 31 and County Road 261 and County Road 275. Applicant - Aaron Rents, Inc.
