

The Pelham City Council convened at 7:00 p.m., Monday, October 6, 1997. Mayor Hayes called the meeting to order and Ken Maynard led the invocation.

Mayor Hayes asked that the record show all members of the council present.

Ken Maynard moved to approve the September 15 minutes as written. Mike Dickens seconded the motion and all approved.

There was no old business to come before the council.

During new business, Ordinance No. 311 annexing property owned by Norman & Jewel Brasher was presented. A resolution was presented approving an ABC application for El Rodeo Mexican Restaurant 020 Retail Liquor. Jim Phillips moved to approve the resolution as presented. Willard Payne seconded the motion and it passed five to one.

A resolution agreeing to improvements and maintenance of the traffic control device at the intersection of Chandalar Drive and Highway 261 was introduced. Karyl Rice moved to approve the resolution as presented. Ken Maynard seconded the motion and all approved.

A resolution was introduced agreeing to improvements and maintenance of the traffic control device at the intersection of Wal-Mart and Highway 31. Jim Phillips moved to approve the resolution as presented. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved.

A resolution was presented authorizing the installation of a street light at Highway 52 East and Parkview Drive and three in the Stonehaven Subdivision. Willard Payne moved to approve the resolution as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

A resolution was introduced authorizing Ken Holler to act on behalf of the City on matters associated with utility agreements. Jim Phillips moved to approve the resolution as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

Karyl Rice announced a public hearing to be held October 20, 197 at 7:00 p.m. to consider Ordinance No. 135-86 changing the present zoning of A-1 Agricultural District to B-2 General Business District on property located on Highway 33.

Mayor Hayes recognized two scouts working on life and citizenship badges.
