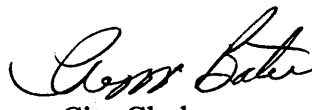
Ken Maynard moved to approve November 3 minutes as written. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved.

During old business a public hearing was held to consider Ordinance No.135-87 changing the present zoning of B-2 General Business District to M-1 Light Industrial District. Applicant - Randall Goggans. No one spoke in favor of or against the zoning. Karyl Rice reported that it came out of Planning and Zoning unanimous. Karyl Rice made a motion to approve as presented and Jim Phillips seconded the motion and all approved.

During new business a resolution was presented appointing Randall Vice to the Planning Commission for a 3 year term to expire Sep 2000 and Clay Johnson to the Industrial Development Board to replace Pat McDonald for a term of 6 years to expire Oct 2003. Jim Phillips moved to approve the resolution as presented and Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved.

A Resolution was presented advancing \$500 cash to Donna Treslar for expenses while attending the National League of Cities Convention in Philadelphia, December 3-7. Ken Maynard made a motion to approve the resolution as presented and Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

With no other business before the council, Willard Payne moved to adjourn. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.
