Ken Maynard moved to approve the April 5 minutes as written. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

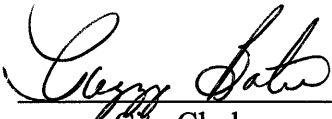
There was no old business to come before the council.
