Ken Maynard moved to approve the June 7 minutes as written. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

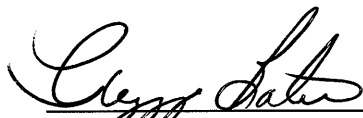
During old business, a public hearing was held to consider Ordinance No. 135-111 rezoning property located on Highway 11 and Henderson Road from A-1 Agricultural to B-2 General Business. No one spoke against the rezoning. Eddie Jowers spoke in favor of the rezoning. Willard Payne moved to approve Ordinance No. 135-111 as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

During new business a resolution was introduced accepting the bid of \$485,309.00 from Alabama Bridge Builders, Inc. for the Crosscreek Trail/Bishop Creek Bridge Project. Karyl Rice moved to approve the resolution as presented. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved.

Willard Payne announced a public hearing to be held July 12 at 7:00 p.m. to consider Ordinance No. 135-112 changing the present zoning of B-2 General Business District to M-1 Light Industrial on property located at 3061, 3065 and 3069 Lee Street. The applicant is George Jones, III.

Mayor Hayes announced that the next city council meeting would be held July 12 at 7:00 p.m.

With no other business before the council Ken Maynard moved to adjourn. Willard Payne seconded the motion and the council adjourned at 7:10 p.m.
