

The Pelham City Council convened at 7:00 p.m., Monday, October 18, 1999. Mayor Hayes called the meeting to order and asked Karyl Rice to lead the invocation.

Mayor Hayes asked that the record show all members of the council present except Ken Maynard and Willard Payne.

Mike Dickens moved to approve the October 4 minutes as written. Jim Phillips seconded the motion and all approved.

During old business a public hearing was held to consider Ordinance No. 135-115 changing the present zoning of A-1 Agricultural to Special District. The property located at Windstone III Subdivision off County Road 36 is ½ mile east of County Road 69. The applicant was Rodney E. Davis. No one spoke for or against the rezoning. Mayor Hayes read a fax to approve from Robert Farmer. Karyl Rice moved to approve Ordinance No. 135-115 as presented. Jim Phillips seconded the motion and all approved.

During new business a resolution was presented appointing Bill Bussey to the Beautification Board, term expiration October 2002. Jim Phillips moved to approve the resolution as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

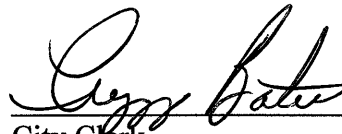
