Mayor Hayes asked that the record show all members of the council present except Mike Dickens and Willard Payne.

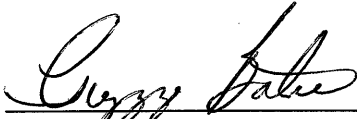
Jim Phillips moved to approve the October 18 minutes as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.
