

The Pelham City Council convened at 7:00 p.m., Monday, November 15, 1999. Mayor Hayes called the meeting to order, and Willard Payne led the invocation. Mayor Hayes asked that the record show all members of the council present.

Jim Phillips moved to approve the resolution as presented. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved.

Ordinance No. 288-1 was presented amending Section 3 of the Business License Schedule and adding Schedule 169 to Section 29. Willard Payne moved to suspend the rules for immediate consideration. Ken Maynard seconded the motion and a roll call vote was taken with the following votes recorded.

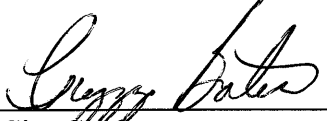
