Mayor Hayes asked that the record show all members of the council present.

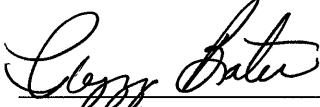
Ken Maynard moved to waive the oral reading of the minutes and approve the February 21 minutes as written. Mike Dickens seconded the motion and all approved.
