COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
April 3, 2000

The Pelham City Council convened at 7:00 p.m., Monday, April 3, 2000. Mayor Hayes called the meeting to order and Willard Payne led the invocation.

Mayor Hayes asked that the record show all members of the city council present except Jim Phillips.

Karyl Rice moved to waive the reading of the March 20, 2000 minutes and approve as written. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved.

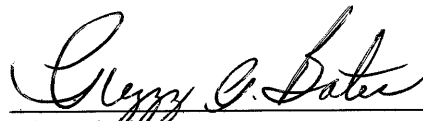
There was no old business.

During new business, a Resolution appointing Johnny Wierengo to the Planning Commission was presented. Willard Payne moved to approve the appointment, Ken Maynard seconded and all approved.

Nextel Communications requested a communication tower at 2794 Pelham Parkway, as other towers in the area do not meet their needs. Key Maynard voiced concern while Jarrod Franklin spoke in favor of the tower. Mayor Hayes questioned the number of Nextels served by a new tower. It was conveyed that the extra tower is for in-city calls for new customers. Ken Maynard moved to approve the communication tower, Willard Payne seconded and the motion was approved with a 3 to 2 vote.

Announcement: A public hearing will be held April 17, 2000, to consider changing the present zoning of A-1 Agricultural District to Special District on property located on Highway 52. The applicant is Awtrey Companies.

With no other business before the city council, Ken Maynard moved to adjourn. Mike Dickens seconded the motion and all approved. The meeting adjourned at 7:31 p.m.
