Mayor Hayes asked that the record show all members of the council present except Jim Phillips and Mike Dickens.

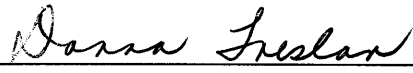
Ken Maynard moved to suspend the oral reading of the July 3, 2000 minutes and approve as written. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved.

During old business, a public hearing was held to consider Ordinance No. 135-122 changing the present zoning of R-3 Residential District to Special District on property located on Highway 68 owned by James P. and Wilma B. Philen. No one spoke for or against the rezoning. Karyl Rice announced that the Planning Commission voted unanimously to recommend rezoning and moved to approve Ordinance No. 135-122 as written. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved.

During new business Mayor Hayes presented a resolution extending the Waste Management contract. Ken Maynard moved to approve as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

Mayor Hayes introduced an ABC application and resolution, 020 restaurant Retail Liquor, for New Adventures, LLC doing business as Big Daddy's Sports Bar & Grill at 2754 Pelham Parkway. Ken Maynard moved to deny the request. Willard Payne seconded the motion, and it passed with a four to zero vote.

With no other business before the council, Ken Maynard moved to adjourn. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved. The meeting adjourned at 7:14 p.m.
