

The Pelham City Council convened at 7:00 p.m., Monday, November 20, 2000. Mayor Hayes called the meeting to order, and Willard Payne led the invocation.

A roll call was taken with all members of the council present.

Mike Dickens moved to suspend the oral reading of the minutes and approve as written. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved.

During old business a public hearing was held to consider Ordinance No. 135-126 re-zoning property located on Highway 119 from A-1 Agricultural to B-1 General Business. The applicant was Norman Sanchez, agent for Murray Family, LLC. Douglas Corretti spoke in favor of the re-zoning stating that the property would be used for private parties, corporate and wedding events. Karyl Rice moved to approve the re-zoning as presented. Jim Phillips seconded the motion and all approved.

During new business, resolutions and an agreement regarding the installation and maintenance of traffic control signals at the intersection of CR 52 and CR 35, known as Project No. SCP 59-380-99 were presented. Jim Phillips moved to approve as presented. Mike Dickens seconded the motion and all approved.

A resolution was presented approving three street lights for Amanda Trace, locations S2485, S-2486 and entrance to subdivision. Willard Payne moved to approve as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

A resolution was introduced authorizing the Mayor to proceed to acquire property by eminent domain in order to provide safe and adequate drinking water to citizens. Jim Phillips moved to approve the resolution as presented. Rosemary Metcalf seconded the motion and all approved.

Ordinance No. 288-3 amending the Business License Ordinance was presented. Karyl Rice moved to suspend the rules for immediate consideration. Jim Phillips seconded the motion and a roll call vote was taken with the following results:

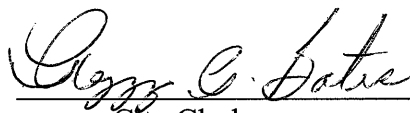
