There was no old business to come before the council.

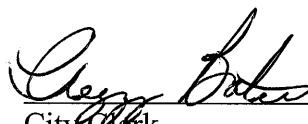
During new business, an ABC Application and resolution was presented for Transfer of 020 Restaurant Retail Liquor for applicant, Darrell Wayne Wyatt, Trade Name - Challenger's. Mayor Hayes asked Mr. Wyatt about his past record and stated that the history of the city council was not to approve applicants with a record. Mr. Wyatt stated that his record was true. Karyl Rice moved to deny the request for a liquor license. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved.

An ABC Application and Resolution was presented for 070 Retail Wine (Off Premises Only) for applicant, Racetrac Petroleum, Inc., Trade Name - Racetrack #050. No one was present to speak for the applicant. Mike Dickens moved to approve the application as presented. Rosemary Metcalf seconded the motion and all approved.

The council considered a tower request from Crafton Communications to be located at 3475 Indian Lake Way. Roy Bracken spoke in favor of the request and stated the tower would handle a dead spot in the area. Karyl Rice moved to approve the request as presented. Rosemary Metcalf seconded the motion and all approved.

A request to collocate an antenna on an existing tower at 1000 Martin Street came before the council. No one was present to represent the applicant. The council moved to table consideration of the request until the January 15 council meeting.

With no other business before the council, Mike Dickens moved to adjourn. Rosemary Metcalf seconded the motion, and the meeting adjourned at 7:17 p.m.
