

The Pelham City Council convened at 7:00 p.m., Monday, February 5, 2001. Mayor Hayes called the meeting to order, and Karyl Rice led the invocation.

Mayor Hayes asked that the record show all members of the council present.

Mike Dickens moved to suspend the oral reading of the January 15, 2001, minutes and approve as written. Rosemary Metcalf seconded the motion and all approved.

There was no old business to come before the council.

During new business, Mayor Hayes introduced a resolution opposing the Uniform Sales and Use Tax Administration Act. Karyl Rice moved to approve the resolution as presented. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved.

A resolution was introduced appointing Pam Kilgo to the Beautification Board to fill the unexpired term of Janet Cain, term expiration October 2001. Willard Payne moved to approve the resolution as presented. Jim Phillips seconded the motion and all approved.

A resolution was presented approving 12 street lights for The Legends at Weatherly Highlands. Jim Phillips moved to approve the resolution as presented. Rosemary Metcalf seconded the motion and all approved.

An ABC Application and Resolution were presented for 040 Retail Beer (On or Off Premises) for Applicant, Daniel Valencia, Trade Name - Taqueria Valencia Mexican Restaurant at 150 Cahaba Valley Road. Jim Phillips moved to approve the application as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

An ABC Application and resolution were presented for 020 Restaurant Retail Liquor for Applicant, Josefina Hernandez, Trade Name Cosina Mexican Restaurant, Inc. The contractor spoke in favor of Ms. Hernandez. The council was assured that the husband would not be at the restaurant. The resolution died for lack of a motion. Mayor Hayes asked three times for a motion.

ABC Applications and Resolutions were presented for 011 Lounge Retail Liquor - Class II (Package); 070 Retail Table Wine (Off Premises Only); and 050 Retail Beer (Off Premises Only) for applicant, Lowery, Inc., doing business as CC Food Mart Package Store at 2837 Pelham Parkway. Jerry Lowery explained what he intended to do as far as separating the types of businesses. Jim Phillips moved to approve the application and resolution as presented. Mike Dickens seconded the motion and all approved.

Mayor Hayes presented Ordinance No. 324-1 amending the sales tax ordinance for a first reading.

Karyl Rice made the following announcement: A public hearing will be held February 19, 2001 at 7:00 p.m. at Pelham City Hall to consider Ordinance No. 135-127 changing the present zoning of B-2 General Business District to M-1 Light Industrial District on property located on Highway 31 and Highway 52. The applicants were listed as David Bishop, Jack McGuire, John McGeever and Connie Standifer.

With no other business before the council, Karyl Rice moved to adjourn. Jim Phillips seconded the motion, and the meeting adjourned at 7:25 p.m.
