

The Pelham City Council convened at 7:00 p.m., Monday, March 5, 2001. Mayor Hayes called the meeting to order, and Karyl Rice led the invocation.

Mayor Hayes asked that the record show all members of the council present.

Mike Dickens moved to waive the oral reading of the minutes and approve the February 19, 2001 minutes as written. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved.

Andy Rotenstreich represented Powertel and stated that the height of each existing tower was 125', 120' and 85'. Jim Phillips moved to approve the request subject to plans and specifications being approved by the city's engineering department or consultant. Rosemary Metcalf seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

A resolution accepting the dedication of Stonehaven Subdivision - Second Addition streets was presented. Jim Phillips moved to approve the resolution as presented. Rosemary Metcalf seconded the motion and all approved.

ABC Applications and resolutions were presented for 050 Retail Beer (Off Premises Only) and 070 Retail Table Wine (Off Premises Only) for applicant, Geaux Meaux L.L.C., Trade Name - Pelham Amoco, located at 2260 Pelham Parkway. Mike Dickens moved to approve the applications and resolutions as presented. Jim Phillips seconded the motion and all approved.

Mayor Hayes recognized Scout Troop 404 from First Baptist Church of Pelham.

With no other business before the council, Willard Payne moved to adjourn, and Karyl Rice seconded the motion. All approved, and the meeting adjourned at 7:15 p.m.
