There was no old business to come before the council.

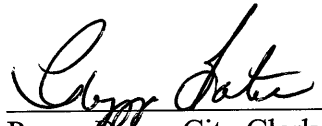

Erica McKinney addressed the council requesting that a stop sign be placed on King Valley Road due to excessive speeding. Jim Phillips stated that the request would be given to the Police Department and Engineering for evaluation and recommendation.
