

The Pelham City Council convened at 7:00 p.m., Monday, May 14, 2001. Mayor Hayes called the meeting to order, and Karyl Rice led the invocation.

Mayor Hayes asked that the record show all members of the council present.

Willard Payne moved to suspend the oral reading of the minutes and approve the May 7, 2001 minutes as written. Rosemary Metcalf seconded the motion and all approved.

During old business, a public hearing was held to consider Ordinance No. 135-129 amending Article XVIII, Supplementary Regulations and Modifications, Section 7, Paragraph 4 of the Zoning Ordinance. Mayor Hayes explained that the amendment dealt with satellite dishes. No one spoke for or against the ordinance. Karyl Rice moved to approve the amendment as presented. Mike Dickens seconded the motion and all approved.

A public hearing was held to consider Ordinance No. 135-130 changing the present zoning of A-1 Agricultural District to M-2 Heavy Industrial District. The property is located on Pardue Road and the applicant was Smith Properties, LLC. Phillip Smith represented Smith Properties and stated they wished to expand a warehouse. He noted that the surrounding property is zoned industrial. No one spoke against the request. Karyl Rice moved to approve Ordinance No. 135-130 as presented. Jim Phillips seconded the motion and all approved.

There was no new business before the council.

With no further business, Mike Dickens moved to adjourn. Rosemary Metcalf seconded the motion and the meeting adjourned at 7:03 p.m.
