Mike Dickens moved to waive the oral reading of the November 19, 2001 minutes and approve as written. Rosemary Metcalf seconded the motion and all approved.

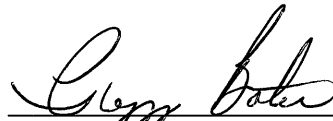
There was no old business to come before the council.
