

The Pelham City Council convened at 7:00 p.m., Monday, January 21, 2002. Mayor Hayes called the meeting to order, and Willard Payne led the invocation. Mayor Hayes asked that the record show all members of the council present.

Karyl Rice moved to waive the oral reading of the minutes and approve the January 7, 2002 minutes as written. Rosemary Metcalf seconded the motion and all approved.

During old business, a public hearing was held to consider Ordinance No. 135-136 amending the text of the Zoning Ordinance, Article XVIII, Supplementary Regulations and Modifications, adding Section 9, Landscaping and Buffers. Mayor Hayes introduced the ordinance and explained the content. He gave Mr. Ronnie Green an opportunity to address the council, but he declined. No one spoke against the ordinance. Karyl Rice stated that the Planning Commission voted unanimously to recommend passage to the city council. Jim Phillips moved to approve Ordinance No. 135-136. Rosemary Metcalf seconded the motion and all approved.

During new business, Mike Orr, Chairman of the Pelham Beautification Board presented awards for the Christmas Decorating Contest to the following people: Fire Station Two, Sonic Drive-In and Gordon and Linda Carroll of 516 Overhill Road. Mayor Hayes thanked the board and the recipients for their work to make Pelham a more beautiful city in which to live.

With no other business before the council, Mike Dickens moved to adjourn. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved. The meeting adjourned at 7:12. p.m.
