Thereupon, Jim Phillips moved to approve Ordinance No. 374-1 as written. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

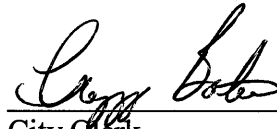
