Mayor Hayes asked that the record show all members of the council present.

Mike Dickens moved to waive the oral reading of the June 17, 2002 minutes and approve as written. Rosemary Metcalf seconded the motion and all approved.

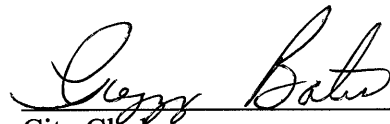
There was no old business to come before the council.

During new business an ABC application and resolution were presented for 050 Retail Beer (Off Premises Only) and 070 Retail Table Wine (Off Premises Only) for applicant Indus, Inc., trade name Pelham BP, located at 2260 Pelham Parkway, Pelham, AL 35124. No one was present to speak for the application. Willard Payne moved to approve the application as submitted. Mike Dickens seconded the motion and all approved.

Ordinance No. 386 prohibiting parking of unattended vehicles on specified streets, roads and highways adjacent to Colonial Pipeline Company and at other points within the city which are designated by order of the Chief of Police as "High Risk" areas, and to provide for the immediate removal of said unattended vehicles was presented. Karyl Rice moved to adopt the ordinance as written. Jim Phillips seconded the motion and all approved.

Mayor Hayes recognized Mr. Roddy Johnson, a member of the Canyon Park Homeowner's Association, who addressed the council regarding animal control issues. He requested the existing leash law be enforced. He stated that dogs and cats are running loose through his neighborhood. He wants the city to improve our animal control, and requested an animal control department be budgeted. Mayor Hayes said he would take it under consideration.

With no other business before the council, Mike Dickens moved to adjourn. Rosemary Metcalf seconded the motion, and all approved. The meeting adjourned at 7:25p.m.
