

The Pelham City Council convened at 7 p.m. on Monday, July 22, 2002. Mayor Hayes called the meeting to order, and Willard Payne led the invocation.

Mayor Hayes asked that the record show all members of the council present.

Mike Dickens moved to waive the oral reading of the minutes and approve the July 1, 2002 minutes as written. Rosemary Metcalf seconded the motion and all approved.

There was no old business to come before the council.

During new business, a resolution was presented appointing Barry Graves to the Park and Recreation Board with a term expiration of March 15, 2004. Mr. Graves will replace Wayne Anderson. Willard Payne moved to approve the resolution as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

A resolution was introduced authorizing Mayor Hayes to enter into a contract with Jack Harrison for assistance in the construction of a municipal golf course. Terms were \$25,000 with \$12,500 being paid at signing and \$12,500 at completion. Jim Phillips moved to approve the resolution as presented. Rosemary Metcalf seconded the motion and all approved.

With no other business before the council, Willard Payne moved to adjourn. Mike Dickens seconded the motion and all approved.
