

The Pelham City Council convened at 7 p.m., Monday, October 21, 2002. Mayor Hayes called the meeting to order, and Karyl Rice led the invocation. Mayor Hayes asked that the record show all members of the council present.

Karyl Rice moved to waive the oral reading of the October 7, 2002 minutes and approve as written. Rosemary Metcalf seconded the motion and all approved.

A resolution was presented authorizing Alabama Power to bill the city for flashing lights at a pedestrian crossing at Southgate Drive and Alabama 119. Willard Payne moved to approve the resolution as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and all approved.

An ABC application and resolution was presented for 020 Restaurant Retail Liquor – applicant Chuen Ping Tebo, trade name – Ping's Chinese Restaurant II located at 212 Cahaba Valley Road. Jim Phillips moved to approve the application and resolution as presented. Rosemary Metcalf seconded the motion and all approved.

ABC applications and resolution were presented for 040 Retail Beer (On or Off Premises) and 060 Retail Table Wine (On or Off Premises) for applicant – Strike Fore, LLC, trade name Strike Fore located at 2613 Pelham Parkway. Richard Klimpt addressed the council explaining the design of the building and where liquor would be sold. Mayor Hayes requested that consideration be tabled until 11/4/02 to give the council members an opportunity to visit the facility to see how it is designed. Jim Phillips moved to table consideration of the ABC applications until the November 4, 2002 meeting. Mike Dickens seconded the motion and all approved.

With no other business before the council, Mike Dickens moved to adjourn. Rosemary Metcalf seconded the motion and all approved. The meeting adjourned at 7:35 p.m.
