

The Pelham City Council convened at 7 p.m., Monday, February 17, 2003. Mayor Hayes called the meeting to order, and Karyl Rice led the invocation.

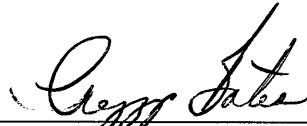
Mayor Hayes asked that the record show all members of the council present except Mike Dickens.

Rosemary Metcalf moved to waive the oral reading of the February 3, 2003 minutes as presented. Karyl Rice seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

During old business a public hearing was held to consider Ordinance No. 135-139 changing the present zoning of M-1, B-4, and B-2 to B-2 General Business District on property located at 2216 Pelham Parkway. The applicant was O. W. Irwin, Jr., Executor of Estate of Claude H. Baldwin, Jr. No one spoke for or against the rezoning request. Karyl Rice stated that the Planning Commission voted unanimously to recommend rezoning to the city council. Karyl Rice moved to approve Ordinance No. 135-139 as presented. Willard Payne seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Mayor Hayes introduced a resolution authorizing city officials to bid the purchase of 10 portable defibrillators for use at municipal and educational facilities. Jim Phillips moved to approve the resolution as presented. Rosemary Metcalf seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

With no other business before the council, Karyl Rice moved to adjourn. Rosemary Metcalf seconded the motion, and the meeting adjourned at 7:07 p.m.
