Thereupon, Karyl Rice moved to approve Ordinance No. 110-83G as presented. Willard Payne seconded the motion and all approved.

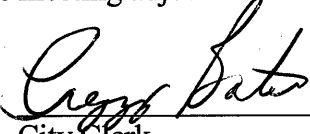
